2. Top 5 Mistakes to Avoid

- Relying only on national sites (half the best deals aren't listed)
- Not reading the lease (especially fees and penalties)
- Touring unverified listings (scam risk!)
- Waiting too long to apply
- Not budgeting for all move-in costs

3. What Landlords Look For in DFW

- Proof of income (2.5–3x rent)
- Clean rental history
- Steady job or verified income (Avoid fake offer letters, apts can sniff these out)
- Credit score minimum 600+ (but not always a deal breaker)

4. Red Flags to Watch For

- Units that look *too* good to be true on the internet (they usually are)
- Private listings that demand money before touring (Huge scam risk! Never do this)
- Vague lease terms or off-the-books rentals

5. Quick Hacks for Finding the Right Spot

- Tour mid-week to beat competition and find better availability and the best specials

- Facebook Groups- sometimes a good resource if you have rental issues (evictions, rental debt, background issues etc.) Search Second Chance Groups
 - Use a locator — saves time & stress, and it's 100% free, plus they know Second Chance Apts to send you to if you have issues.
